






### WHAT DID WE DO DURING THIS WORKSHOP AND TO BE DONE?

### Horizon 2020 in a nutshell

- The EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014 - 2020)
- Focus on innovation: closing the gap between knowledge and market, stronger participation of SMEs, enhanced publicprivate collaborations
- New strategy for international cooperation
- Strong focus on **Societal Challenges** facing EU society: addressing people's concerns about their livelihoods, safety and environment

### Open to the world!

- ✓ Cross-cutting ambition (3 priorities) to increase intl coop
- **✓** Strategy for international cooperation:
  - General opening of Horizon 2020 ("bottom up" approach): <u>applicants</u> from non-EU countries are always welcome to apply to H2020 calls even if call/topic text does not state this explicitely
  - Targeted international cooperation actions ("top down" approach):
     areas for cooperation & partner specified upfront, with scale and scope to achieve impact
    - → Multi-annual roadmaps for key partner countries/regions
  - Stronger partnership with Member States





### **Eligibility for funding – General rules**

 Participation open to all non-EU countries, but they are not always automatically entitled to funding

### AUTOMATICALLY ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING

- EU Member States (MS)
- The Overseas Countries and Territories (OCT) linked to MS
- H2020 associated countries
- Non-EU applicants listed in the Work programme (Annex A)
- International European interest organisations

#### **OTHERS**

(including international organisations)

### Funding possible if:

- Provided for under a bilateral scientific and technological agreement
- Stated in the Work Programme
- Participation of an entity is essential (e.g. outstanding competence/expertise; access to research infrastructure; access to particular geographical environments; access to data)





### Financing / Calendar of calls

- Instruments: Research and Innovation Actions (=collaborative research projects); Support & coordination actions;... For R&I Actions:
   minimum 3 legal entities of different MS or AC
- **Financing**: about 3 6 millions € / project, other amounts possible depending on calls.
- One funding rate, based on the type of instrument and type of actor (non profit versus private actors)
  - Maximum of 100% of direct costs
  - Indirect eligible costs: a flat rate of 25% of direct eligible costs
- Tentative calendar for next 2016 2017 calls
  - January June: preparation of the content of the WP2016/17
  - In the course of summer: Adoption of the WPs; Publication of the calls for 2016/17

### "Health, demographic change and wellbeing" Workprogramme 2014 -2015

#### Personalising Health and Care

PHC-04-2015: Health promotion and disease prevention: improved intersector co-operation for environment and health based interventions

Two stage : Deadlines : 14/10/2014 (1st stage) and 21/04/2015 (2nd stage)

**Type of action**: Research and innovation actions

Financing: between EUR 4 and 6 million, but other amounts are possible

#### **Health Coordination Activities**

HCO-12-2015: ERA NET: Antimicrobial resistance

DL: 24/02/2015

Type of action: ERA-NET Co-fund

Financing: minimum of EUR 5 million,
